__ Bugs & Butterflies	June 24-27	Join us for a fun filled week of all things bugs & butterflies. We will explore the life cycle of butterflies as well as investigate some bugs that live in Washington. We will take a look at the American bumblebee, a stink bug, a lady bug, ants and the salmon fly.

___ Lego Camp	July 8-11	Watch your preschoolers eyes light up as they explore the world of legos. We will build bridges, make patterns, rescue a lego guy from ice and make lego boats!
___ Under the Stars	July 15-18	Let's go camping this week! We will build a pretend camp fire, sing songs, explore the stars and go on a nature hike.
___ Pack your passport	July 22-25	This week we will visit a different country each day and learn about their culture. Pack your passport and suitcase as we head to Australia, Canada, Japan and Italy!
___ Paint the World	July 29 -August 1	Calling all painters! This week we will be learning different painting techniques. Get ready... some techniques might be kind of silly like using your feet to paint and painting the sidewalk with water toys.
___STEM Camp	August 5th - 8th	This one is for all the little scientists! This week will be focused on all things related to Science, Technology, Engineering & Math.
___ ABC Bootcamp	August 12 -15	It's almost time for school to start, let's get ready! We will use our creative curriculum through the week with a special focus on transitions and circle time.

Policies and Procedures

1. Keeping everyone healthy is one of our major goals at Rainy Dayz. The school is cleaned in its entirety at the end of each school day. We will also ask that your child use antibacterial hand sanitizer (except in the event of an allergy at which point we will ask that you wash their hands) before entering the classroom. If you notice any signs of illness or know your child was recently exposed to an illness, please do not bring your child to Rainy Dayz. Please refer to the parent handbook for guidelines of when to keep your child home from school. **Please call and let us know if your child will be absent from school.**
2. Medications: If your child requires daily medication, Rainy Dayz will administer only after you have completed a medicine disbursement form and the medication is in its original packaging; this includes over the counter medications as well. **DO NOT** put meds in your child's backpack. They must be handed to the teacher with the completed disbursement form.
3. Rainy Dayz is a tobacco, drug and weapon free environment. We have a no tolerance policy and any student who brings any of the above mentioned to school will be expelled immediately.
4. Parents are always welcome at Rainy Dayz. We ask that you advise your child's teacher in advance if you wish to visit the classroom.
5. Our goal at Rainy Dayz is to provide a fun, clean, nurturing and safe environment for your child to learn. Hitting, spitting, kicking or any other type of violent behavior will not be accepted at Rainy Dayz. Appropriate language is also an expectation of all students. Disrespectful behavior or language will not be tolerated. If a child is deliberately harming himself or herself or other children, they will be removed from the classroom immediately and we will contact you for a possible pick up.
6. Safety drills (earthquake/fire/other emergency) will be practiced at Rainy Dayz. We will advise you of the first few times but the others will be spontaneous throughout the year.
7. Please send your child to school every day well rested, well fed and prepared to learn. Please bring a backpack to school with a change of clothing and/or diapers. Communication from your teacher or the office will be sent home in your child's backpack. A communication folder may be provided by your child's teacher for important information and completed works.
8. Sun Screen needs to be applied to your child before school. Sun screen is considered a medication and would need a doctor's note in order for teachers to apply.
9. Please park in unmarked parking areas (no signage unless it is Rainy Dayz signage) and walk your child in for drop off. Please follow the same parking rules for pick up.
